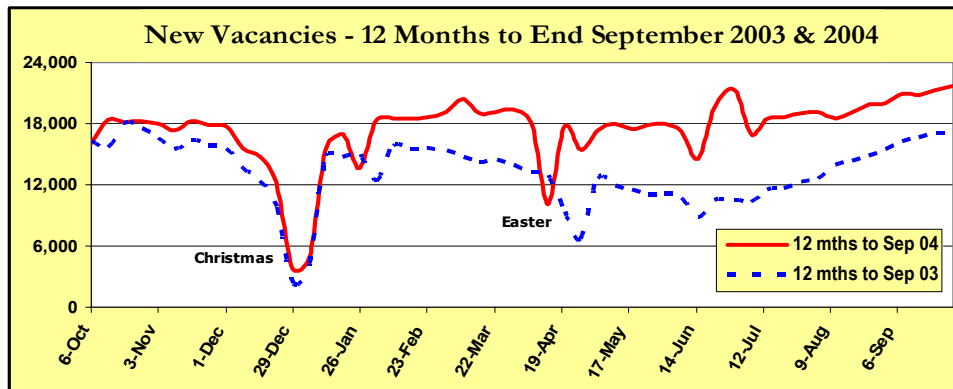
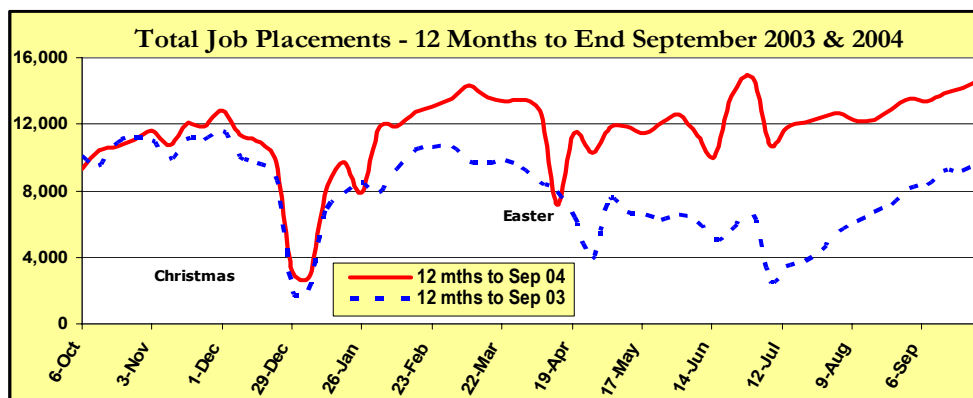




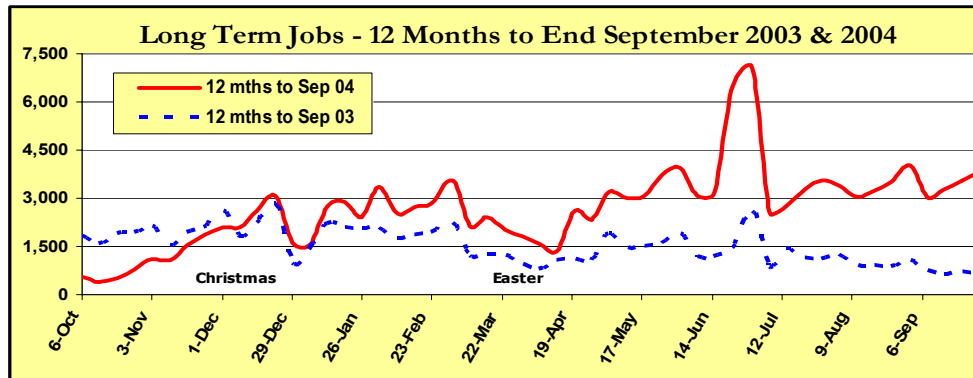
Job Network Performance Profile – Year to end September 2004



- ✓ In the 12 months to end September 2004, over 907,300 new vacancies were lodged on the national vacancy database, an increase of 30 per cent on the previous year.
- ✓ More than 93,100 new vacancies were lodged in the month of September 2004, an increase of 26 per cent on September 2003.



- ✓ In the 12 months to end September 2004 a total of around 601,800 job placements were recorded by Job Network members and other Job Placement Organisations, an increase of 48 per cent on the previous year.
- ✓ In the year to end September 2004, over 245,700 job placements were recorded for the long-term unemployed. More than 89,600 job placements were recorded for job seekers identified as highly disadvantaged.
- ✓ Over 61,900 job placements were recorded in the month of September 2004, an increase of 53 per cent on September 2003.



- ✓ In the 12 months to end September 2004, over 135,000 long-term (13 week) jobs were achieved for disadvantaged job seekers and those unemployed for more than three months. Over 15,200 long-term jobs were achieved in the month of September 2004, more than double the number in September 2003.
- ✓ In addition to the 135,000 long term jobs in the year to end September 2004, around 5,800 education and training outcomes (the completion of approved semester courses) were achieved for Intensive Support participants.
