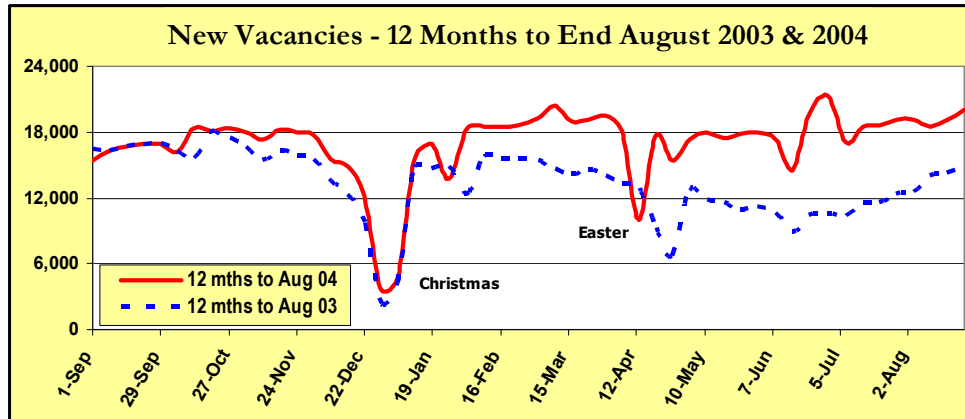
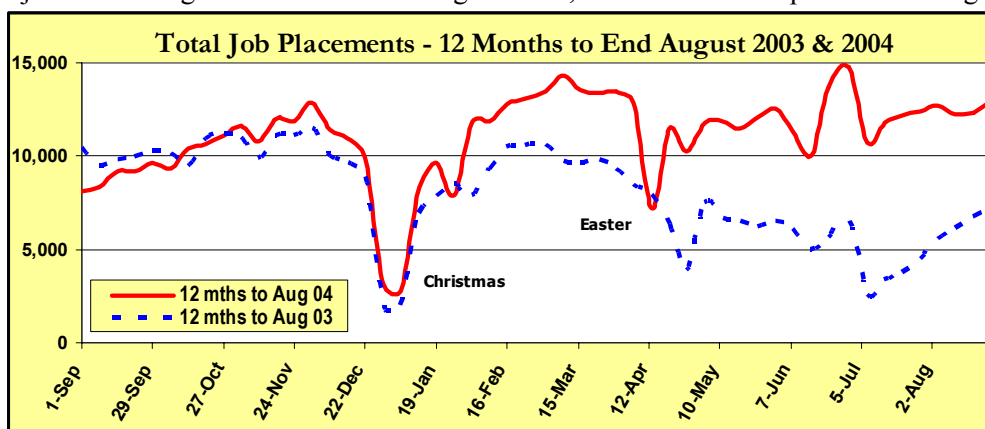




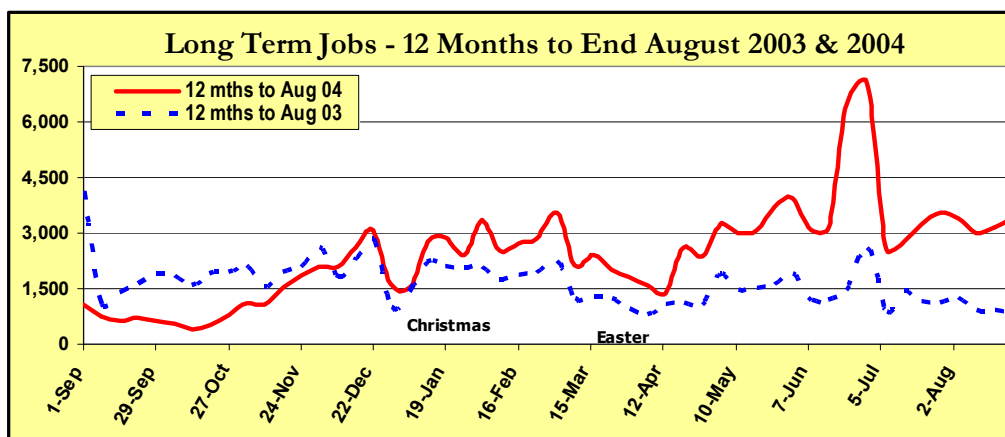
## Job Network Performance Profile – Year to end August 2004



- ✓ In the 12 months to end August 2004, 888,000 new vacancies were lodged on the national vacancy database, an increase of 28 per cent on the previous year.
- ✓ Over 85,000 jobs were lodged in the month of August 2004, an increase of 42 per cent on August 2003.



- ✓ In the 12 months to end August 2004 a total of 580,500 job placements were recorded by Job Network members and other Job Placement Organisations, an increase of 42 per cent on the previous year.
- ✓ Over 56,400 job placements were recorded in the month of August 2004, almost double the number for August 2003.



- ✓ In the 12 months to end August 2004, almost 122,300 long term (13 week) jobs were achieved for disadvantaged job seekers and those unemployed for more than three months. Over 14,300 long term jobs were achieved in the month of August 2004, more than double the number in August 2003.
